
In Regina, EVRAZ employs approximately **1,000 people**




Since 2006, Enbridge has purchased more than **2.6 million tons** of line pipe from EVRAZ





The vast majority of line pipe for the new Line 3 was manufactured in Regina and at a sister facility in Alberta




Safety and Quality




EVRAZ meets our demands for high-quality pipe, with more rigorous and frequent testing than industry standards

96% of EVRAZ pipe steel is made of recycled metal – not only a green product, but excellent chemistry for line pipe
